


PROGRAM DEMOGRAPHICS

GENDER




72.7% identified as female/woman27.3% identified as male/man


RACE / ETHNICITY



ANNUAL INCOME




NATIVE LANGUAGES




Most of READ Ottawa's program participants are considered to be low-income or poverty level. For many immigrants and refugees, they want to work, but are unable to do so until they can obtain a work visa. On average, it takes U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) 3-6 months to process a work visa application. Other individuals are stay-at-home parents to alleviate the cost of childcare on the family.

READ Ottawa was finally able to act on our promise to expand to Holland/Zeeland in 2022. Much of the funding that was received in 2020-2021 for the expansion was reserved for 2022 in order to expand on our programming and operations to serve residents of the Holland area. In 2022, READ Ottawa increased its annual budget and raised more than we ever have before in history to meet the needs of adult learners!
