In addition to owning Baker Lumber, from which he retired, Bruce served on local advisory boards, acted in the local theater, coached many sports, and invested in his family.

Bruce was a member of the first READ Ottawa tutor training class in 2009. He went on to tutor many learners both as a full time tutor and a substitute when needed. Bruce only recently stepped down from tutoring in January 2025. He was committed to the success and dignity of each learner.


