MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In 2024 **READ Ottawa** served over **100 new learners**, expanded our reach across southern Ottawa County to include Hudsonville. **Strengthened** our partnerships with libraries, schools, and community organizations. We created a **Memorandum of Understanding** with Allegan Adult and Online Education, Allegan District Library and the Allegan County Community Foundation to form a pilot program that mirrors **READ Ottawa**. We also launched new tutor trainings, enhanced our learner-centered resources, and **began building a foundation** for long-term sustainability and impact.

Literacy opens doors—to employment, education, citizenship, and confidence. Every success story we've witnessed this year is a **testament to what's possible** when a community believes in the power of education. 


LEARNER DEMOGRAPHICS

GENDER




RACE / ETHNICITY




PLACE OF RESIDENCE




NATIVE LANGUAGES




COUNTRY OF ORIGIN
