Our mission is to provide adults who live in or near Ottawa County with an opportunity to improve and transform their lives by strengthening their reading and language fluency.

Our Impact

READ Ottawa is the only nonprofit organization that provides free one-on-one adult literacy education tutoring to adults in Ottawa County.

Since 2010, over 250 learners have enrolled in our program. This group is diverse, with participants working across various sectors like manufacturing, construction, farming and many other industries.

Over 40% of our learners have improved their English language skills, which is a crucial step toward personal and professional growth. Additionally, 28% of our learners have obtained better employment opportunities. More than a dozen have earned their GED or high school diploma, many have obtained U.S. Citizenship, applied for new jobs and improved their engagement within our community.

We currently have over 120 dedicated tutors working with our learners, contributing more than 3500 combined service hours. Our tutors provide not just academic support, but inspiration and compassion. Their impact goes beyond teaching; they are creating a supportive environment that fosters growth and confidence.



What We Do

Our learners set ambitious goals while juggling jobs and family obligations. Our oneon-one tutoring sessions can cover a number of subject areas, depending on learner goals. We help our learners with:

- Speaking and Listening Skills
- U.S. Citizenship Test Prep
- GED Test Prep
- Reading, Writing, & Literacy Skills
- English as a Second Language
- Driver's License Written Test Prep
- Improving Employment and Financial independence
- Increasing Community Involvement
- Family Literacy Skills, including reading to their children and being involved in their education

When literacy improves within our communities, everyone wins!


